Oklahoma FBLA is pleased to announce the Oklahoma POWER Series! The POWER Series which stands for Preparing Oklahoma's **W**inners through Education & Readiness will allow members to compete against others in the state in all events with an objective test component.

Who?

All members of Oklahoma FBLA are encouraged to participate. This activity is great practice for the State Leadership Conference.

What?

This competition is only open to current Oklahoma FBLA members. Members compete against others in the state with state-level recognition.

When?

- Registration will open **December 1** and close at 5:00pm on Friday, **January 9**.
- No changes or additions will be made after 5:00pm on Friday, **January 9**.
- Advisers will receive testing instructions and log-in information by **Thursday, January 15**.
- Testing begins on Monday, **January 19**.
- Testing closes promptly at **5:00pm on Friday, January 30**.
- There is no late registration for this event.
- Winners will be announced by Friday, **February 6**.
- Advisers will have access to results by the week of **February 16**.

Where?

Online! For this competition, the requirements are that tests be taken in your school environment and be proctored throughout the entire testing time. There is flexibility in the proctoring role. We do not require a business educator to proctor so you can ask other school staff members to proctor so students can complete tests at a time convenient to everyone. All participants will receive a ribbon at SLC to showcase their achievement.

Testing

Testing procedures will be sent to advisers by **January 15**. After the competition winners are announced, advisers will be able to access scores.

Competitions

There is no limit on the number of competitors per event a chapter may have. Each member may participate in 5 (five) online tests. Objective tests are not available for the Collegiate level events. Collegiate members may take any of the high school division objective tests as practice for their competitive events.

Registration Process

The registration fee is \$15 per student for up to 5 tests.

BluePanda will be used for testing. Registration opens Monday, **December 1**. To access registration go to:

Collegiate, FBLA High School or Middle School members are eligible to participate. A member is defined as a student with paid membership in the national system (FBLA Connect).

Select students to participate first, then add the competitions for each student.

IMPORTANT: A generic invoice from BluePanda will be automatically generated. **Do not pay the BluePanda invoice!** An official invoice from Oklahoma FBLA will be sent to the adviser email address listed in the registration process. Invoices from Oklahoma FBLA for the Oklahoma POWER Series must be paid before the chapter will be able to register for SLC.
